PLAYER ELIGIBILITY


Player eligibility is determined by each school's governing club sports participation policies. The NFHL abides by and enforces each school's eligibility policies. Each school must submit a roster that is verified by a Club Sports Representative, validating that all players are eligible to participate based on <u>their</u> specific school policies.

The NFHL is a coed league and has been since its inception in 1997.

The NFHL is deeply committed to the safety and well-being of all participants in league events. *Effective 1/1/24*, the NFHL adopted a zero-tolerance Code of Conduct policy and believes that these measures will contribute towards a more positive and enjoyable experience for everyone involved. The Code of Conduct applies to anyone attending or participating in an NFHL event.

27TH ANNUAL FALL CHAMPIONSHIP & CHALLENGE CUP

This is the 27th Annual Fall Tournament weekend, the Championship being invite-only and Challenge Cup open to all active teams. These are two highly competitive tournaments, showcasing incredible collegiate field hockey clubs from schools across the US.



FALL RANKINGS

Only teams that played at least 7 regular 2024 fall season games were ranked by:

- Average game points per game (AVE GP = total game points / # games played)
 - Tiebreaker #1: greatest average goal differential (AVE GD = total goals scored total goals against / # games played)
 - Tiebreaker #2: least average goals against (AVE GA = total goals against / # games played)
 - Tiebreaker #3: greatest average goals scored (AVE GS = total goals scored / # games played)

CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY & QUALIFICATION DETAILS

- Played minimum 7 games vs. active NFHL teams.
- Maximum 2 forfeit wins count towards record.
- Up to 2 games vs. same opponent will count towards record.
- The top 16 teams will advance to championship after the adjustments above.

CHALLENGE CUP ELIGIBILITY

• The Challenge Cup is open to all active NFHL teams. There are no minimum game requirements.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE & SCHEDULE*

- The preliminary schedule will be released early-November. The final schedule will be released by November 15th (subject to change).
- Teams will play 4 pool play games, consisting of 23-minute halves. Subject to change.
- Pool play games will be held on Friday and Saturday of the tournament.
- Teams that requested a Friday exemption or late start, will be notified by email if granted.
- Six Championship and six Challenge Cup teams will advance to their respective playoffs.
- The Championship games will be held at 11:45am ET on Sunday.
- Games may need to be switched/rearranged due to reasons outside of our control.
- Teams must be available to play from 7am-7pm on Friday (unless you request a Friday exemption), 7am-7pm on Saturday, and 7am-2pm on Sunday.

*Subject to change due to inclement weather, cancellations or extenuating circumstances.




RESULTS & STANDINGS



CODE OF CONDUCT: ZERO TOLERANCE

All teams will be required to send a signed <u>Code of Conduct</u> simultaneous with the submission of your verified roster for all NFHL tournaments and events. Please note that it is the captain/coach's responsibility to ensure that all individuals associated with your team, including, but not limited to, players and spectators, are aware of and understand the policy ahead of the tournament. The NFHL is deeply committed to thesafety and well-being of all participants in league events and believe that these measures will contribute towards a more positive and enjoyable experience foreveryone involved.

Key Points:

- <u>Zero Tolerance Policy</u>: The NFHL operates under a zero-tolerance policy for any form of discrimination, harassment, or derogatory comments based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or any other protected characteristic.
- <u>Immediate Consequences:</u> Any individual found in violation of the zero-tolerance policy will face immediate consequences, including removal from the premises or expulsion of their team from the tournament.
- <u>Team Responsibility:</u> Teams, especially coaches/captains, are responsible forensuring that their fans/spectators adhere to the Code of Conduct. Separate incidents involving different individuals supporting the same team will result in theentire team's disqualification from the tournament.
- <u>Reporting:</u> All instances of misconduct or violations of the Code of Conduct should immediately be reported to the NFHL via GroupMe message, followed by a detailed email to <u>info@nationalfieldhockeyleague.com</u>.


