# TOURNAMENT RULES

- **Teams are not permitted on the fields before they open.** Fields open at: Friday: 7:45am Saturday: 7:00am Sunday: 7:15am
- **Captains must check in using the online check-in form 30 mins prior to every game time.**
- All players must be registered on the team's LeagueApps roster by the assigned deadline and must complete all waivers prior to participation.
- Player eligibility is determined by each school's club sports participation policies. All players must be verified by a club sports rep on the final roster, confirming that they meet all university participation requirements.
- **Teams listed on the left wear white/light jerseys.** Teams listed on the right wear dark jerseys.
- Male Players (Regular and OT): Before the start of each game, teams must confirm (with each other and the umpires) how many male field players each team has present on the sideline (excluding the goalie). The team with more male field players is allowed to play "up two" during regulation and overtime play (excluding the goalie). The number of male field players allowed (confirmed at the start of the game), cannot be changed during the game (penalty cards, injuries, etc. do not affect it) – **regardless of how many male players are fielded. If both teams agree to modify this rule for their game, the adjustment will be permitted. However, the agreed-upon modification must remain in effect for the entire game and both team captains must inform the umpires of the modification prior to the start of play.**
- Umpires will keep time on field - it is running time. No timeouts.
- **Captains of both teams must report the score** using the GroupMe after each game.
- Pool Play: 25-min halves, 5-min halftime, 5-min between games. No OT. No timeouts. Running time.  
**Championship:** each team plays 4 games – 3 pool games and 1 crossover game.  
**Challenge Cup:** each team plays 4 games against teams in their group.
- Game Points: 3 points for a win, 1 point for a tie, and 0 points for a loss.
- Rankings: total game points, highest goal differential, least goals against, highest goals scored, head-to-head, coin toss.
- Playoff Teams: **Championship** – 8 teams will advance (#1 and #2 from each pool)  
**Challenge Cup** – 6 teams will advance (#1 and #2 from each group)
- Playoff Games: 25-min halves, 5-min halftime. OT. No timeouts. Running time.
- Playoff Overtime: straight to shootout (best of 5, sudden victory).

## CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

**Zero Tolerance Policy:** The NFHL operates under a zero-tolerance policy for any form of discrimination, harassment, or derogatory comments based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or any other protected characteristic.

**Immediate Consequences:** Any individual found in violation of the zero-tolerance policy will face immediate consequences, including removal from the premises or expulsion of their team from the tournament.

**Team Responsibility:** Teams, especially coaches/captains, are responsible for ensuring that their fans/spectators adhere to the Code of Conduct. Separate incidents involving different individuals supporting the same team will result in the entire team's disqualification from the tournament.
